2. Subject matter of the proposed rule:

The Resident and Non resident Pharmacy rule addresses changes identified by the Board during its 5-year rule review in September 19997 and other changes made necessary by the Precursor Chemical bill, H.B. 2448, passed by the 1999 legislature. Section R4-23-606 was part of a final rulemaking submitted to GRRC in September 2000, by the Board decided to remove the Section after GRRC staff requested extensive changes. Section R-423-607 is a new rule approved by GRRC on November 7, 2000. In the final days before approval, the Board discovered that nonresident pharmacies were left out of the rule. This was an inadvertent mistake that would make a substantive change to that rulemaking, so Board staff decided to proceed with the final rulemaking with the intent of opening a docket to amend Section 607 to include nonresident pharmacies as soon as possible.

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) established a Unified Water Quality Permit (UWQP) program to streamline the water quality permitting process. Several new general permits are incorporated in the UWQP rulemaking. The UWQP rulemaking should be effective on January 1, 2001 assuming that the final rulemaking is approved by the Governor's Regulatory Review Council on December 5, 2000. ADEQ is opening this docket to make technical corrections and to propose a phase-in schedule for the nitrogen management requirements for onsite wastewater treatment facilities.
