# 2. The public information relating to the listed Sections:

This notice provides notice of and explanation for the Supplemental Proposed Rulemaking that has been initiated on R12-4-316, which was originally a part of the rulemaking included in a Notice of Rulemaking Docket Opening filed with the Secretary of State and published under the following *Arizona Administrative Register* citation: 5 A.A.R. 4503, November 26, 1999. Under the Notice of Rulemaking Docket Opening filed with the Secretary of State and published in 5 A.A.R. 4503, November 26, 1999, R12-4-316 was originally a part of rulemaking that also included R12-4-313, R12-4-406, R12-4-407, and R12-4-411. Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for R12-4-313, R12-4-316, R12-4-406, R12-4-407, and R12-4-411 was filed with the Secretary of State and published in 6 A.A.R. 2669, July 14, 2000.

At their October 21, 2000, meeting, the Arizona Game and Fish Commission directed the Department to modify the proposed rulemaking language of R12-4-316 to include an exemption pertaining to the possession and transportation of live crayfish in the Yuma area. In summary, the possession, transportation, and importation of live crayfish would be prohibited statewide, except for the portion of La Paz County west of Highway 95 and south of Interstate 10; Yuma County and on the Colorado River from the Palo Verde Diversion Dam downstream to the Southern international boundary with Mexico. This action by the Arizona Game and Fish Commission necessitated the filing of a Notice of Supplemental Proposed Rulemaking for R12-4-316. The other 4 rules (R12-4-313, R12-4-406, R12-4-407, and R12-4-411), which were a part of the rulemaking in the Notice of Rulemaking Docket Opening, are now split off from R12-4-316 and are proceeding along the original rulemaking timeline toward the filing of a Notice of Final Rulemaking, but is now doing so as a part of the Supplemental Proposed Rulemaking process.
