The purpose of the statute is to ensure the accuracy and reliability of breath testing devices and to facilitate the apprehension and prosecution of drivers who are operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. R9-14-403 and R9-14-404 implement the statute by providing devices, methods, and procedures approved by the Department to detect the presence of alcohol in motor vehicle drivers. On May 26, 1999, under the authority of A.A.C. R9-14-403(K), the Director approved the Intoxilyzer 5000EN as a quantitative alcohol breath-testing device and approved a standard operational procedure, two standard calibration check procedures, and two standard quality a0ssurance procedures for its operation. The Intoxilyzer 5000EN and the standard operational procedure, calibration check procedures and standard quality assurance procedures were added to the rules by the emergency rulemaking process, filed with the Secretary of State's office on May 24, 2001. The purpose of this rulemaking is to add the Intoxilyzer 5000EN and the standard operational procedures and standard operational procedure, calibration check procedures to the rules by the regular rulemaking process.
