Over the past three years, the Arizona Uniform Plumbing Code Commission has adopted and amended the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials' (I.A.P.M.O.) 1994 Uniform Plumbing Code (U.P.C.), including its appendices and installation standards, as the state plumbing code.

March 20, 2001, the Commission came together to produce a timeline and code amendment submittal guidelines for the public to submit amendments to the Arizona State Plumbing Code. The timeline and guidelines were distributed to potential proponents with a deadline for submittal of June 1, 2001. On July 9 and 10, 2001, the Commission met to review 15 submittals. Of the 15, 11 of the submittals were approved, some with modification.

This Notice of Rulemaking Docket Opening is in preparation to submit the proposed amendments for consideration.
