# 2. Subject matter of the proposed rule:

In 2000, the legislature passed SB 1330. Under SB 1330, effective July 1, 2001, all authority for regulation of Health Care Service Organizations (HCSOs) was consolidated under the Arizona Department of Insurance (ADOI). The principal effect of the consolidated regulatory structure is to bring new responsibilities to the Department. The Department will write rules to define basic health service, make and maintain determinations and enforce rules that establish whether an HCSO provides for basic health care services and whether it constitutes an effective mechanism to achieve an effective health care plan. At the same time, ADOI will amend or repeal the requirements currently under R20-6-405. ADOI will also retain authority to review, approve, suspend or revoke certificates of authority for HCSOs.
