- 2. The subject matter of the proposed rule:**
A.R.S. § 45-332 was enacted into law in 2005. It requires community water systems outside of AMAs and those community water systems within AMAs that are exempt from filing annual reports under A.R.S. § 45-632 to file annual reports with ADWR. The statute does not specify the date by which a community water system must file an annual report. This proposed new section will provide that the reports under A.R.S. § 45-332 are to be maintained on a calendar year basis and filed with ADWR no later than June 1 of each year for the preceding calendar year. The section adds a deadline, six months, to prepare and file the report.
