The Arizona Department of Transportation engages in this rulemaking, in a combined effort with the Overdimensional Permit Council and other representatives of the regulated community, to ensure the effectiveness of its overdimensional permit rules in achieving statutory objectives under A.R.S. Title 28, Chapter 3, Articles 18 and 19. The Department, with regard to public safety and in anticipation of its approaching deadline to report on the effectiveness of these rules to the Governor's Regulatory Review Council by March of 2008, anticipates amending the rules by the end of this year. The rule amendments are intended to correct any outdated information and statutory references, provide further clarification on existing processes to ensure the public safety, and ensure the rules are clear, concise, and understandable. In the near future, the Department and the Overdimensional Permit Council will publish additional notices to ensure that all interested parties are provided sufficient opportunity to participate in this rulemaking effort.
