Article 4, Design and Operation of On-Line Games, provides for the conduct of the Lottery's on-line games. These rules are being amended to accommodate new initiatives that are considered on-line games, but play similar to a traditional instant game. Playstyles will be added to provide consistency with the Lottery's instant game rules. The provisions in the rules explain the common components of on-line games: game profiles, ticket purchases, drawings, ticket ownership and responsibilities, identifying a winning ticket, procedures to claim prizes, ticket validation requirements, and disputes concerning a ticket.
