During its 2009 session, the legislature passed S.B. 1104, which amended A.R.S. §§ 36-446.03(B) and 36-446.12(A), to allow the Board to increase the fees charged for it licensing and regulatory activities. The bill also clarified that an individual may seek the Board's approval of a continuing education. The bill required the Board to establish a percentage limitation on the amount by which a fee may be increased. This rulemaking will increase fees and makes conforming changes.
