This requirement is excessive for programs seeking occasional, episodic placements of individual students. Programs seeking approval for a limited experience will be required to supply contact information; program accredi-

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tation status; faculty qualifications, supervision arrangements, and AZ or multi-state compact RN license number; a clinical contract with the facility where the students will be placed; the names of the students; and names and RN license number of the assigned preceptors.
