### NOTICES OF SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENTS

A substantive policy statement does not include internal procedural documents that only affect the internal procedures of the agency and does not impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties or include confidential information or rules made in accordance with the Arizona Administrative Procedure Act. If you believe that a substantive policy statement does impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties you may petition the agency under A.R.S. § 41-1033 for a review of the statement.

This instruction provides guidance in the application of OSHA'S National Emphasis Program (NEP) for inspecting facilities with highly hazardous chemicals in the amount at or greater than the threshold quantities listed in 1910.119. Arizona Division of Occupational Safety and Health (ADOSH) will apply this guidance during programmed and unprogrammed inspections of facilities that are found to have quantities of highly hazardous chemicals as listed in 1910.119.
