The policy invites people to resolve complaints through a discussion, and if that fails, then through a written complaint. A written complaint should contain details about the allegation and needs to be submitted within 60 days of the alleged violation to the Department's Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator. The Coordinator will meet with the complainant within 15 days and respond in writing within 15 more days. A person may appeal a decision to the Director of the agency. The Department will make available alternative means of submitting grievances for persons with disabilities, upon request.
