The proposed rulemaking covers three separate subjects. The first subject is to establish the process in rule, as required by A.R.S. § 6-949, for converting a mortgage banker license to a mortgage broker license.

The second subject is to establish a process that allows for mortgage brokers to convert their license to a commercial mortgage broker license, as authorized by the passage of HB2004 (commercial mortgage brokers; license conversion) during the 50th Legislature, 1st Regular Session.

The third subject is to implement HB2296 (national banks; mortgage loan originators), also passed during the 50th Legislature, 1st Regular Session, by establishing the fee, application, and renewal process for applying for a certificate of exemption in order to supervise mortgage loan originators.
