On April 7, 2011, the Governor signed SB1248 (Laws 2011, Ch. 43), which requires the Arizona Department of Health Services (Department) to revise rules to eliminate the dual licensing requirements for hospitals that provide organized psychiatric services. Currently, a hospital providing organized psychiatric services is required to be licensed as a hospital under *Arizona Administrative Code* (A.A.C.) Title 9, Chapter 10, Article 2, and as a behavioral health service agency under 9 A.A.C. 20. The Department has exempt rulemaking authority until July 1, 2012 to make these revisions. The Department has completed draft rules incorporating into 9 A.A.C. 10, Article 2 the requirements for psychiatric services provided by a hospital in an organized unit and has posted the draft rules on the Department website (http://www.azdhs.gov/diro/admin rules/dual.htm).
