The department limits the emission of air contaminants through Rule 314 (Open Outdoor Fires and Indoor Fireplaces at Commercial and Institutional Establishments) which is applicable to any open outdoor fire as well as burning in indoor fireplaces at commercial and institutional establishments. The department is proposing a limited revision to Rule 314 to address testing of potentially explosive-containing products during restricted-burn periods. In addition, the department is proposing to make grammatical changes and syntax modifications, e.g., standardize Operation and Maintenance Plan language and remove obsolete compliance schedule requirements, to increase standardization within and among rules.
