Pursuant to Laws 2012, Ch. 321, the Arizona Department of Administration (ADOA) has been granted authority to adopt rules relating to personnel and personnel administration for both covered and uncovered employees in the State Personnel System. Section 170, paragraph A, authorizes exemption from the rulemaking requirements of A.R.S. Title 41, Chapter 6, for the purpose of establishing rules pursuant to this Section until April 30, 2013.

In order to implement the provisions of Ch. 321, ADOA anticipates that the rules will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Classification system
- Recruitment, selection and appointment of candidates
- Changes to employment status
- Compensation system
- Leave benefits and administration
- Performance management
- Procedures for employee complaints alleging discrimination or harassment
- Procedures for discipline and review by ADOA of specified disciplinary actions
- Probationary periods for covered employees
- Grievance and appeal rights for covered employees
- Reduction in force procedures for covered employees
